

Custom Shop Graphics Guidelines

- 1. Board graphic design should be provided as an Adobe Illustrator (AI) file or an EPS file.
- 2. Create outlines on type (lock fonts).
- 3. Include high-resolution graphic elements in EPS, TIFF or PNG format
- 4. Include a print-quality PDF version of the design document.
- 5. The document size should be 2" larger than the graphic designed area on all sides.
- 6. Place trim (printer) marks on all four corners of the board graphic. Trim marks should be two lines crossing each other at 90 degrees to form a cross hair.
- 7. Bleed to the edge of the document's design area.
- 8. Caution: The design should consider that a portion of each side will be covered by the frame and, if selected, the marker tray.
- 9. The frame will cover 5/8'' on all sides.
- 10. If a marker tray is selected, that will cover 1.25" of the bottom of the board.
- 11. Graphic will be printed 4-color (Cyan, Magenta, Yellow and Black), on a wide format HP inkjet printer. If the graphic calls for a specific Pantone® color, we will use process colors to come as close a possible. Refer to a Pantone® Solid to Process Color book to get an idea of how the process color will compare to the Pantone® spot color.
- 12. Identify all graphic elements with your organization's name.
